STEP 1: PRIORITISE SAFETY

USE PROPER EQUIPMENT

Ensure you have a sturdy ladder, non-slip shoes, and, if possible, a safety harness.

Avoid inspecting your roof in wet, windy, or icy conditions.

STEP 2: CHECK THE OVERALL STRUCTURE

VISUAL INSPECTION

- Stand at a distance where you have a clear view of the entire roof.
- Look for any signs of sagging or uneven roof lines. The roof should appear uniformly straight along its ridges and valleys.
- Observe the condition of the roof shingles or tiles. Uneven, missing, or damaged shingles can indicate underlying structural issues.

GUTTERS AND DOWNSPOUTS

- Check if the gutters and downspouts are straight and aligned with the roof's edge.
- Sagging gutters or gaps between the roof and gutters can suggest structural problems.

STEP 3: ON THE ROOF

SAFETY FIRST

If you step onto the roof, use a sturdy ladder, wear non-slip shoes, and consider using a safety harness. Always have someone with you for safety.

SURFACE INSPECTION

Walk along the roof (if safe) and feel for soft spots underfoot. These could indicate rot or damage to the sheathing underneath the shingles.

CHOOSE GOOD WEATHER


Look for damaged, loose, or missing shingles, which can be signs of underlying structural issues.

FLATNESS

The roof should be mostly flat. Bumps, waves, or depressions can be signs of problems.

STEP 4: ON THE ROOF

STRUCTURAL BEAMS AND RAFTERS

Check the condition of the structural beams and rafters from inside the attic. Look for any signs of bending, cracking, or wood rot.

SAGGING

Notice if there is any sagging between the rafters or trusses. This could indicate a structural weakness.

LIGHT PENETRATION

Look for any light coming through the roof boards. Light penetration can be a sign of gaps or holes in the roof.

WATER DAMAGE

Check for any signs of water damage, such as dark spots, trails, or mould. Water damage can weaken the roof structure over time.


VENTILATION
